The MASTER in these cases was given to the largest bass. There have also been a couple of years where there were four different anglers in four different categories but once again the bass division ruled.

PICKING OF THE MASTER: A job given to all the past "MASTERS" throughout the years. The Masters assemble in a room at the conclusion of Saturdays weigh-in to pick the current year winner. Saturday evening the past Master will award the green jacket and the HAROLD SHEPPARD TROPHY to this individual. The Master jacket can only be won once by an individual.(this was decided by the committee in 1994 after John Marc Cloutier had won it two years in a row)
